Tips

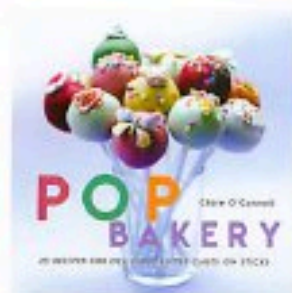
The POPs will keep for a week in the fridge or two days at room temperature. Don't leave finished POPs in the fridge uncovered as they will sweat.
